SUBMISSION TO CONSULTATION ON THE DEFINITION OF A CHARITY

Westcare Inc. has endorsement as an income tax exempt charitable entity under Section 50B of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

Westcare has been established since 1946 during which time it has been actively involved in charitable collections in support of its mission statement: "WESTCARE Inc. a charitable organisation formerly known as The Tuberculosis and Chest Association of Western Australia, exists to enhance the lives of people with disabilities and to assist their integration into the community, while at the same maintaining a concern for the control of Tuberculosis".

We welcome the broad direction of the draft Charities Bill 2003 with the following exceptions:

- We advocate removing restrictions on the advocacy and lobbying role of charities
 contained in Clause 8 of the draft. We support ACOSS in its request that a better
 approach which is less intrusive and burdensome for charities is to recognise that charities
 may engage in non-partisan advocacy that is an integral part of a strategy to promote an
 underlying dominant charitable purpose, such as relieving poverty, protecting the
 environment or supporting people with disabilities.
- We advocate the establishment of a Charity Commission which has the expertise to
 regulate access to charitable status which is currently regulated by the ATO. We strongly
 support that such a body works closely with the State Government agencies charged with
 regulating charities so that all levels of government are encouraged to adopt identical
 definitions of charitable status and administrative guidelines to implement them.
